Garment Sewing Basics

1 session class for Adults \$55 class fee includes kit

Using square and curved rulers and your measurements you will draft a pattern on paper then construct in muslin to fit and adjust if necessary. You can then use this pattern to design other styles of your choice. Prerequisites: Absolute Beginners, Start to Sew! or other pattern sewing class. Must know how to use classroom machine. Alterations Part I

1 session class \$30 class fee

Wed May 8, 5 - 7pm

Learn from an experienced tailor how to improve the fit of readymade garments such as: taking in & letting out seams including boned bodices or bustier, darts & gussets, narrow shoulders, balance/even out drape of skirt, adjusting for sway back, Dowager's Hump, high hip, adjusting waist, seat and stride. The exact agenda will be determined at the start of the class based on the garments brought in by or preferences requested by the students. During the class garments can be pinned and marked for fitting with instructions on how to complete the alteration at home. The instructor will also have samples for demonstration purposes. Quilting

Start Quilting!

1 session class

\$60 class fee plus cost of supplies

Sat May 18, 10:15 – 2:15pm

This class is for those with basic sewing skills who have never quilted, or those with minimal quilting experience. The topics to be covered include: rotary cutting, sewing exact seam allowances (1/4 inch), making strip sets, chain sewing, joining blocks, pressing (versus ironing), preparing fabrics for quilting (washing, starching/sizing) and selecting fabrics (color, value, scale). All topics will involve discussion and demonstration of techniques, tips, safety issues, etc., as well as hands-on practice for students for all topics. The skills you learn in this class, as well as the supplies you purchase, are the basics to get you started quilting, and will be essential for future quilt classes. Star Table Runner

2 session class

Home Dec

The Cornice

2 session class

Nothing does more for a room than good window treatments and the cornice is a versatile window topper with many possibilities and works well in any decorating scheme. Using a flat wooden board and decorator fabric of you choice you'll make a shaped or flat cornice to enhance your windows and room décor. You need to come to class prepared with fabric, tools and the board already constructed. Supply list will be given upon registration. \gg Ginny Davey

Pinch-Pleated Drapes

3 session class \$120 class fee plus cost of supplies

Thu June 6, 13, & 27, 6:30 - 8:30pm

Classic pleated draperies are the ultimate window treatment for versatility and style. Installed on traverse rods, they easily open to reveal the full window view. When closed, they offer privacy, light control, and even insulation. They can also be made as stationary draperies. Traditional threefold pinch pleats will create uniform, graceful folds. You will learn how to cut and sew decorator fabric and lining. In order to complete this project in the allotted time only a single small window is acceptable. Fabrics will be purchased during first session. Must already have sewing skills for this class. Homework will be assigned after first class. Kids & Teens Can Sew Workshop

1 session class for kids ages 10 and up \$22 class fee includes supplies

If your child has never sewn on a machine and has the desire to learn, this is where to start. This class is also the prerequisite to Kids and Teens Sewing 101. Kids will learn basic sewing skills including how to sew straight, measuring, using the machine correctly, and sewing safety, all while making a tote bag they can keep. We supply all the materials and tools for the class. Please note: important sewing machine information along with machine safety is covered during the first 15-20 minutes of this class, therefore we will turn away any latecomers. **

Kids Hand Sewing: Needle Case

1 session class for kids ages 9 and up \$20 class fee includes supplies

This two-hour workshop teaches basic hand stitching using needle, thread and felt. Kids will learn more basic stitches along with how to sew on buttons and snaps while making a needle case. No prerequisite. >< *Nancy Plominski*

Sewing 101

4 session class for ages 10 and up \$107 class fee plus supplies

Sat May 11, 18, June 1 & 8, 2:30-5:00pm (first session is 2:30-4:30pm)

Kids will learn fundamental sewing skills as he/she makes elastic waist pajama pants. Young sewers will learn how to take their measurements, read a pattern envelope and pattern instructions, handle fabric, use tools, follow and cut a pattern along with construction and finishing techniques. Threading the sewing machine, winding the bobbin, machine safety and how to use the machine is reviewed. How to insert elastic along with proper pressing techniques will be taught. Fabric, elastic and thread will be purchased at the end of the first class. The total cost for these supplies can range from approx. \$18 to \$30 depending on which fabric is chosen. The teacher will show students which fabrics are appropriate for the pants and point out the price. Please advise your child on how much he/she should spend or please feel free to join the class as fabrics are chosen and guide your child to a fabric with a price you are comfortable with. All fabrics are priced per yard.

Kids Sewing 102

4 session class for ages 10 and up \$100 class fee plus supplies

Using a pattern, kids will make a cute fitted a-line short skirt with darts, waistband and a zipper closure. More sewing techniques will be learned along with how to sew in a zipper, apply interfacing and getting the right fit and length. Kids Summer Tunic Top

3 session class for ages 12 and up \$75 class fee plus supplies

Sew Your Own

4 session class for ages 12 and up \$140 class fee plus supplies

Students will chose their own pattern, buy the needed materials and supplies, and make a garment (ollowing the pattern directions themselves. Our teacher will assist with correct sizing and interpreting directions as needed. Students may use the serger machine to finish seams. Prerequisite: Kids/Teens Can Sew Workshop, Sewing 101 and 102. Students must know how to use the Bernina 330 classroom sewing machine.

Brownie and Girl Scout Programs at Fabricland

Free "Sew Simple" Tour - for girls ages 7- 17

Groups of 8 or less visit the pattern, fabrics, notions, trim and sewing machine departments and learn about the 'world of sewing' through a fun and informative 45-minute "after-school" tour.

"Scouts Can Machine Sew" Workshop – For girls ages 10 –17 A hands-on class for groups of 10 or less, this two-hour program is the same as the "Kids Can Sew" workshop listed above. Teaches basic sewing skills to those who have never sewn on a machine. This is a great introduction class for after-school or evenings. \$20 per girl includes supplies.

"Scouts Can Hand Sew" Workshop – For girls ages 9 –17 This hand sewing class is for groups of 8 or less. This two-hour workshop teaches basic hand stitching using needle, thread and felt. Kids will learn various basic stitches along with how to sew on buttons while making their project. \$20 per girl includes supplies.

Fabricland Registration and Tuition Policies:

Payment in full is required for class registration. Please arrive for your class prepared to start on time. In consideration of all students, latecomers may be turned away at the discretion of the instructor. Supply list, if necessary, will be given upon registration.

Supply Lists: Supply lists will be given upon registration if a class requires one. Please come to class prepared with supplies and materials required.

Refund Policy: There are no refunds on classes. A student may reschedule a class once provided notice is given at least 72 hours prior to class time. Rescheduled classes must be taken within 90 days of original class date. If Fabricland needs to cancel a class due to lack of enrollment, students will be given their choice of a refund or a substitution class. There are no refunds or rescheduling if canceling out of a class within 72 hours of class date and time.

Parents: When dropping off your children, please check-in with the instructor before leaving your child. Please pick-up children at the designated time. There is no supervision outside of classroom hours.

Inclement Weather: If the weather is a concern and you think your class may be cancelled please call 908-755-4700 ext. 140. If the store is open the class will be held. If we cancel a class or session due to the weather it will be rescheduled and you will be notified.

Do not bring your own sewing machine to class. Bernina sewing machines are used in our classrooms. Bring your own machine only when class description indicates to do so.

Please mark your calendar with the date your class is scheduled to begin. Fabricland will not call or send out additional reminders before your class starts.
