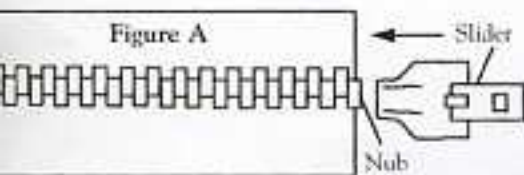


How to: Assemble a Zipper Chain

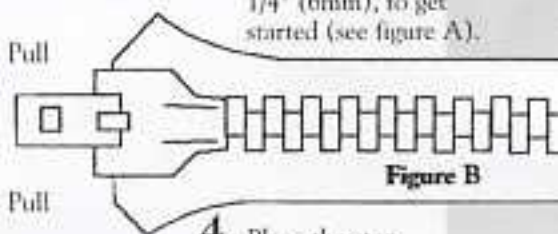
Sometimes referred to as "zipper by the yard", Zipper Chain allows you to customize a zipper to fit any size opening you may have. It is perfect for slipcovers, sleeping bags, throw pillows or tents.

1. Measure opening for zipper and add at least $1/2"$ (13mm) on each end for seam allowances. This will be the length of Zipper Chain you need to cut.

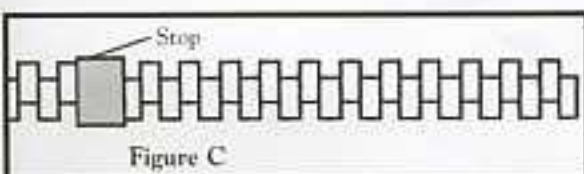


2. Look at the zipper teeth. Hold the zipper so that the nubs on the teeth point up. Line up the bottom of the slider to the zipper teeth. Place slider over the teeth as far as you can, about $1/4"$ (6mm), to get started (see figure A).

3. Gently pull the tape on each side of the slider to separate the teeth inside the slider (see figure B). You should see the slider begin to move down the teeth. Pull the slider downward and stop a few inches from the bottom.



4. Place the stop $1/2"$ (13mm) from the end of the tape, over the teeth, pushing the prongs through the tape on the other side. With pliers, squeeze the prongs flat over the teeth like a staple (see figure C).
