



Summer Sewing Camp Class Schedule July – August 2020



This summer we have ten weeks of great classes sewing fashion and accessories for kids ages 8-17. Students will learn sewing techniques, measuring and cutting skills along with how to follow pattern directions and sewing safety. Sewing machines are provided our classroom. If required a supply list will be given upon registration. Class size is small so register early at Fabricland.com or call 908-755-4700. Students will take a short snack break in classes that are over two hours long. If attending the morning and afternoon sessions kids can bring lunch and stay for the break.

Week 1: June 29 - July 2

Kids & Teens Can Sew Workshop

Age 8+

\$25 class fee includes supplies

1 session Mon June 29, 10:30am – 12:30pm

Kids will learn basic sewing skills including how to sew straight, some measuring, using the machine correctly, and sewing safety, all while making a cute tote bag. We supply all the materials and tools for the class. No experience needed. Please note: important sewing machine information along with machine safety is covered during the first 15 minutes of this class, therefore we will turn away any latecomers. ☞

Poolside

Age 8+

3 sessions Tue June 30 – Thu July 2, 10:30am – 12:30pm

Kids will learn how to make a bathing suit cover up, headband, and scrunchie using a beach towel. Boys can make shorts or pants.

Students only need to bring a beach towel to class. Required prerequisite: Kids & Teens Can Sew Workshop. ☞

Sewing 101: P.J. Pants

Age 8+

4 sessions Mon June 29 – Thu July 2, 1:30 – 4:00pm (First session is 1:30 – 3:30pm)

Kids will learn fundamental sewing skills as they make elastic waist pajama pants. Young sewists will learn how to take their measurements, read a pattern envelope and instructions, handle fabric, use tools, and follow and cut a pattern along with construction and finishing techniques. Threading the sewing machine, winding the bobbin, machine safety and how to use the machine is taught and reinforced (along with safely using the iron for pressing). *Fabric, elastic, and thread is included in the class fee and will be selected by students at the end of the first session. Fabrics will need to be washed and dried to pre-shrink before the next session.* Required prerequisite: Kids & Teens Can Sew Workshop. ☞

An easy breezy summer look for over a bathing suit or everyday wear. The cover up has a drawstring neck that forms shoulder straps and ties in a bow and A-line flare hem. Pull on shorts have an elastic waist. Perfect for lightweight cotton fabrics and hot summer days. Pre-requisite: Sewing 101: PJ Pants or equivalent experience. ☞☞

Sewing Accessories

Sewing requires a lot of tools, supplies, and a place to put them. In this class we will stitch up these decorative and functional sewing accessories: a basket for carrying everything, a sewing kit, and a pin cushion. All are great for sewing organization at home or when taking class. ✂✂✂

Get Quilty

This is a very cute fit and flare dress for girls. The fitted bodice features back straps and a bow, the skirt part of the dress is flared. Techniques for sewing with stretch knit fabric will be learned while constructing the dress. ✂✂✂

This pullover hoodie has a loose fit, kangaroo pocket, and full length sleeves. Kids will learn how to follow pattern directions, sew with moderate stretch fabric, sew in sleeves, a hood, pocket, and twin-needle hemming. Prerequisites: Kids & Teens Can Sew Workshop and Sewing 101, or equivalent experience. ✂✂

Back to School Look

Get ready for school with a new look! In this fashion class students will make a tunic top and leggings. They will work with woven and stretch knit fabrics, learn how to sew sleeves, make gathers, make buttonholes and sew on buttons. The leggings have an elastic waist. Prerequisites: Kids & Teens Can Sew Workshop and Sewing 101, or equivalent experience. ✂✂

Get Ready for School

Age 10+

\$120 class fee plus supplies, includes patterns

3 sessions Mon Aug 31 – Thu Sep 2, 1:30 – 4:30pm

Head back to school with a personalized book bag tote, pencil case with a zipper closure and cute bookmark. Kids will learn how to sew a zipper, how to sew in lining and handles, make a patch pocket with flap and embroider their name or initials on the pocket

Fabricland Registration, Tuition, and Classroom Policies:

New Procedures: Our Summer Camp classes will be limited to four students and one teacher. Each student will be assigned a sewing machine, cutting table, and iron to use exclusively each class session. These items specifically and the classroom in general will be sanitized between the morning and afternoon classes and at the end of the day. If a student is displaying signs of illness they will not be permitted to stay. Students are required to wear masks and wash their hands at the beginning of class and after any breaks.

Tools & Supplies: Supply lists will be given upon registration if a class requires one. Students must come to each class prepared with their own tools, supplies, and materials required. Tools must be labeled with students name or initials on them and will not be shared.

Payment & Refund Policy: Payment in full is required for class registration. There are no refunds on classes. A student may reschedule a class once provided notice is given at least 72 hours prior to class time. Rescheduled classes must be taken within 90 days of original class date. If Fabricland needs to cancel a class due to lack of enrollment, students will be given their choice of a refund or a substitution class. There are no refunds or rescheduling if canceling out of a class within 48 hours of class date and time. Fabricland is not responsible for a registrant's decision not to complete a course nor will receive compensation if classes are missed.

Attention Parents: When dropping off your children, please check-in with the instructor before leaving your child. Please pick-up children at the designated time. If someone different will be picking up your child please give their name and phone number to the teacher. There is no supervision outside of classroom hours. Please arrive prepared to start on time. In consideration of all students, latecomers may be turned away at the discretion of the teacher.

Please mark your calendar with the date the class is scheduled to begin. Fabricland will not call or send out additional reminders before the class starts.

Kids may bring a light snack and beverage. If staying for the morning and afternoon sessions they can bring lunch and stay.
