Class Schedule

July – August 2021

This summer we have ten weeks of great classes sewing fashion, accessories, and quilting for kids ages 8-17. Students will learn sewing techniques, measuring, and cutting skills along with how to follow pattern directions, using an iron, and sewing safety. Sewing machines are provided our classroom. If required a supply list will be given upon registration. Class size is small so register early at Fabricland.com or call 908-755-4700. Students will take a short snack break in classes that are over two hours long. If attending the morning and afternoon sessions kids can bring lunch and stay for the break. Face masks are required for students and teachers.

Week 1: June 28 - July 1

Pillow Party 1

Age 8+

Beginner level

\$125 class fee includes supplies

4 sessions Mon June 28 – Thu July 1, 10:30am – 12:30pm

A great class for beginners that focuses on sewing straight and curved seams. Students will make four pillows using cotton fabric and patterns that includes letters for initials, as well as heart, star, and bow shapes. ✂

Scrunchies & Bandidies

Age 8+

Beginner level

\$135 class fee includes supplies

4 sessions Mon July 28 – Thu July 1, 2:00 – 4:30pm

In this fun class students will learn how to sew cute jumbo scrunchies, scrunchies with bows, wide, narrow, pleated, and stretchy headbands. Patterns and instructions provided in class. ✂

Week 2: July 5 - 9

Sewing 101

Age 8+

Beginner level

\$195 class fee includes supplies

5 sessions Mon July 5 – Fri July 9, 10:30am – 1:00pm (First session is 10:30 – 12:30pm)

Kids will learn fundamental sewing skills as they make elastic waist pajama pants and a small tote bag. Young sewists will learn how to take their measurements, read a pattern envelope and instructions, handle fabric, use tools, and follow and cut a pattern along with construction and finishing techniques. Threading the sewing machine, winding the bobbin, machine safety and how to use the machine is taught and reinforced (along with safely using the iron for pressing). *Fabric, elastic, and thread is included in the class fee and will be selected by students at the end of the first session. Fabrics will need to be washed and dried to pre-shrink before the next session.* ✂

Beachy Accessories

Age 9+

Advanced Beginner level

5 sessions Mon July 5 – Fri July 9, 2:00 – 4:30pm

Carry your beach & pool necessities in style with two super cute accessories made in this class. Using patterns and following directions, students will learn how to make a large beach tote with lining and a pocket and a coordinating zippered pouch. ✂✂

Week 3: July 12 - 16

Beach Cover Up & Shorts

Age 8+

Advanced beginner level

\$150 class fee plus supplies

5 sessions Mon July 12 – Fri July 16, 10:30am – 1:00pm

An easy breezy summer look for over a bathing suit or everyday wear. The cover up has a drawstring neck that forms shoulder straps and ties in a bow and A-line flare hem. Pull on shorts have an elastic waist. Perfect for lightweight cotton fabrics and hot summer days. Prerequisite: Sewing 101 or equivalent experience. ☞☞☞

Summer Daze Quilt

Age 8+

Beginner Level

\$175 class fee includes supplies

5 sessions Mon July 12 – Fri July 16, 2:00 – 4:30pm

Kids will learn cutting, sewing, and machine quilting skills while making a cozy throw size rag quilt. "Rag" quilts have frayed edges and great visual textural appeal so kids can have fun mixing the fabrics and colors.

Week 4: July 19 - 23

Pillow Party 2

Age 8+

Advanced beginner level

\$185 class fee includes supplies

5 sessions Mon July 19 – Fri July 23, 10:30am – 1:00pm

Kids will build on basic sewing skills and more while learning how to make a reading pillow and patchwork pillow with applique and reverse applique. Basic sewing skills needed. Taking our Pillow Party 1 or Sewing 101 helpful. ☞☞☞

Sewing 101

Age 8+

Beginner Level

\$195 class fee includes supplies

5 sessions Mon July 19 – Fri July 23, 2:00 – 4:30pm (First session is 2:00 – 4:00pm)

Kids will learn fundamental sewing skills as they make elastic waist pajama pants and a small tote bag. Young sewists will learn how to take their measurements, read a pattern envelope and instructions, handle fabric, use tools, and follow and cut a pattern along with construction and finishing techniques. Threading the sewing machine, winding the bobbin, machine safety and how to use the machine is taught and reinforced (along with safely using the iron for pressing). *Fabric, elastic, and thread is included in the class fee and will be selected by students at the end of the first session. Fabrics will need to be washed and dried to pre-shrink before the next session.* ☞

Advanced beginner level

5 sessions Mon July 26 – Fri July 30, 10:30am – 1:00pm

These cute high-waisted pants feature a paper bag waist, two types of pockets and work well with light drapery fabrics; perfect for summer. More sewing techniques to build on after taking Sewing 101. ☞☞☞

Slouchy Summer Hobo Bag

Age 9+

Advanced beginner

\$175 class fee includes supplies

5 sessions Mon July 26 – Fri July 30, 2:00 – 4:00pm

A slouchy hobo bag is cute for every day use especially to the pool or beach and it reversible! Students will learn about sewing straight and curved seams, interfacing, pockets, pressing, topstitching, and more while constructing the bag. Some sewing experience is required or our Sewing 101 class. ☞☞☞

Week 6: Aug 2 - 6

Needle & Textile Arts

Age 8+

Beginner level

\$135 class fee includes supplies

5 sessions Mon Aug 2 – Fri Aug 6, 10:30am – 12:30pm

This class will give students a taste for different needle and textile arts. Students will make projects and learn about weaving, embroidery, sewing, and applique. ✂

Get Quilty

Age 8+

Beginner level

\$150 class fee plus supplies

5 sessions Mon Aug 2 – Fri Aug 6, 2:00 – 4:30pm

In this beginner level class kids will learn quilting basics and how to piece together cotton fabric "blocks" to make a cozy, throw-sized quilt (approx. 37" x 56"). We will use the tying technique to secure the quilt layers together and also make a coordinating pillowcase. ✂

Week 7: Aug 9 - 13

Sewing 101

Age 8+

Beginner level

\$195 class fee includes supplies

5 sessions Mon Aug 9 – Fri Aug 13, 10:30am – 1:00pm (First session is 10:30am – 12:30pm)

Kids will learn fundamental sewing skills as they make elastic waist pajama pants and a small tote bag. Young sewists will learn how to take their measurements, read a pattern envelope and instructions, handle fabric, use tools, and follow and cut a pattern along with construction and finishing techniques. Threading the sewing machine, winding the bobbin, machine safety and how to use the machine is taught and reinforced (along with safely using the iron for pressing). *Fabric, elastic, and thread is included in the class fee and will be selected by students at the end of the first session. Students will create something new out of something old or used in this creative reuse class. Students will bring in clean used clothing and/or textiles from home or thrift stores. We will have scrap fabric, trims and embroidery floss from the classroom available too. ✂

Week 8: Aug 16 - 20

Casual Style

Age 10+

Advanced beginner level

\$150 class fee plus supplies

5 sessions Mon Aug 16 – Fri Aug 20, 10:30 – 1:00pm

Using stretch knit fabrics, kids will learn how to make leggings and a long or short sleeve t-shirt. Some skills in this class are: handling, cutting, and sewing stretch fabrics, sewing in sleeves, and hemming with a twin needle. Prerequisite: Sewing 101, or equivalent experience. ✂✂

Back to School Accessories

Age 9+

Advanced beginner level

\$150 class fee plus supplies

5 sessions Mon Aug 16 – Fri Aug 20, 2:00 – 4:30pm

Get ready for school in style with these four accessories: a pencil roll, a monogram bag with zipper closure, a reusable snack bag, and a reversible drawstring bag to hold everything. Skills learned: centered zipper, sewing straight, top stitching, appliqué, applying interfacing, and sewing in lining. Prerequisite: Sewing 101, or equivalent experience. ✂✂

Cute Pants!

Age 11+

Advanced beginner level

\$150 class fee plus supplies

5 sessions Mon Aug 23 – Fri Aug 27, 10:30am – 1:00pm

These cute high-waisted pants feature a paper bag waist, two types of pockets and work well with light drapery fabrics; perfect for summer. More sewing techniques to build on after taking Sewing 101. ✂✂

3 sessions Mon Aug 30 – Wed Sep 1, 10:30am – 1:00pm

This is a great introduction to hand sewing and embroidery using embroidery floss and felt. Students will learn how to straight stitch, sew on buttons and beads, different embroidery stitches while making a stuffed cat, dog, Robot, and cookie. ✂

Scrunchies & Bandies

Age 8+

Beginner level

\$135 class fee includes supplies

4 sessions Mon Aug 30 – Thu Sept 2, 2:00 – 4:30pm

In this fun class students will learn how to sew jumbo scrunchies, scrunchies with bows, wide, narrow, pleated, and stretchy headbands. Patterns and instructions provided in class. ✂

Fabricland Registration, Tuition, and Classroom Policies:

New Procedures: Our Summer Camp classes will be limited to four students and one teacher. Each student will be assigned a sewing machine, cutting table, and iron to use exclusively each class session. These items specifically and the classroom in general will be sanitized between the morning and afternoon classes and at the end of the day. If a student is displaying signs of illness they will not be permitted to stay. Students are required to wear masks and wash their hands at the beginning of class and after any breaks.

Tools & Supplies: Supply lists will be given upon registration if a class requires one. Students must come to each class prepared with their own tools, supplies, and materials required. Tools must be labeled with students name or initials on them and will not be shared.

Payment & Refund Policy: Payment in full is required for class registration. There are no refunds on classes. A student may reschedule a class once provided notice is given at least 72 hours prior to class time. Rescheduled classes must be taken within 90 days of original class date. If Fabricland needs to cancel a class due to lack of enrollment, students will be given their choice of a refund or a substitution class. There are no refunds or rescheduling if canceling out of a class within 48 hours of class date and time. Fabricland is not responsible for a registrant's decision not to complete a course nor will receive compensation if classes are missed.

Attention Parents: When dropping off your children, please check-in with the instructor before leaving your child. Please pick-up children at the designated time. If someone different will be picking up your child please give their name and phone number to the teacher. There is no supervision outside of classroom hours. Please arrive prepared to start on time. In consideration of all students, latecomers may be turned away at the discretion of the teacher.

Please mark your calendar with the date the class is scheduled to begin. Fabricland will not call or send out additional reminders before the class starts.

Kids may bring a light snack and beverage. If staying for the morning and afternoon sessions they can bring lunch and stay.
