



# Summer Sewing Camp

## Class Schedule

### July – August 2022

This summer we have ten weeks of great classes sewing fashion, accessories, and quilting for kids ages 8-17. Students will learn sewing techniques, measuring, and cutting skills along with how to follow pattern directions, using an iron, and sewing safety. Sewing machines are provided in our classroom. Class size is small so register early at **Fabricland.com** or call 908-755-4700. Students will take a short snack break in classes that are over two hours long. If attending the morning and afternoon sessions kids can bring lunch and stay for the break. Face masks are optional for students and teachers. We look forward to sewing all summer.

#### **Week 1: June 27 - 30**

##### **Pillow Party**

Age 8+

Beginner level

\$130 class fee includes supplies

4 sessions, 10:30am – 12:30pm

A great class for beginners that focuses on machine sewing straight and curved seams. Students will make four pillows using cotton fabric and patterns that includes letters for initials, as well as heart, star, and bow shapes. ☞

##### **Hand Sewing & Embroidery**

Age 8+

Beginner level

\$130 class fee includes supplies

4 sessions, 2:00 – 4:00pm

All of the project in this class will be made with hand sewing and embroidery. Various hand sewing and embroidery will be taught while making each project. A great class for all levels. ☞

#### **Week 2: July 5 - 8**

##### **Poolside**

Age 8+

Beginner level

\$125 class fee includes patterns

4 sessions, 10:30 – 12:30pm

Kids will learn how to make towel shorts, a scrunchie, and a drawstring bag using a beach towel or terrycloth fabric. Required prerequisite: Kids & Teens Can Sew Workshop. ☞

##### **Get Quilty**

Age 8+

Beginner level

\$150 class fee plus supplies

4 sessions, 2:00 – 4:30pm

In this beginner level class kids will learn quilting basics and how to piece together cotton fabric "blocks" to make a cozy throw-sized quilt (approx. 37" x 56"). We will use the tying technique to secure the quilt layers together. Required prerequisite: Kids & Teens Can Sew Workshop. ☞

#### **Week 3: July 11 - 15**

##### **Sewing 101**

Age 8+

Beginner Level

\$200 class fee includes supplies

5 sessions, 10:30am – 1:00pm

Kids will learn fundamental sewing skills as they make elastic waist pajama pants and a small tote bag. Students will learn how to take their measurements, read a pattern envelope and instructions, handle fabric, use tools, and follow and cut a pattern along with construction and finishing techniques. Threading the sewing machine, winding the bobbin, machine safety and how to use the machine is taught and reinforced along with safely using the iron for pressing. *Fabric, elastic, and thread is included in the class fee and will be selected by students at the end of the first session. Fabrics will need to be washed and dried to pre-shrink before the next session.* ☞

### **Week 3: July 11 - 15 (cont'd)**

#### **Bag It!**

Age 8+

Advanced beginner level

\$200 class fee includes supplies

5 sessions 2:00 – 4:30pm

Kids will sew up a cross body bag with applique, embroidery & zipper, a pencil case, and a striped ribbon zip pouch. Our Sewing 101 or equivalent sewing experience is helpful. ✂✂

### **Week 4: July 18 - 22**

#### **Cute Bedroom Décor**

Age 8+

Beginner level

\$200 class fee includes supplies

5 sessions, 10:30am – 1:00pm

Create cool stuff for your space! In this class kids will learn how to make a patchwork pillow, felt flower garland, a bedside pocket organizer, and fabric collage wall art. ✂

#### **Summer Daze Top & Shorts**

Age 10+

Advanced beginner level

\$175 class fee plus supplies

5 sessions, 2:00 – 4:30pm

Students will learn how to take their measurements, cut the patterns, and following sewing directions while making a cute top and shorts perfect for hot summer days. The pullover top has shoulder straps, elasticized ruffles and flounce. The shorts have patch pockets and a drawstring waist. Prerequisite: Sewing 101 or equivalent experience. ✂✂

### **Week 5: July 25 - 29**

#### **Super Cute Summer Dress**

Age 10+

Advanced Beginner level

\$175 class fee plus supplies

5 sessions, 10:30am – 1:00pm

Students will learn how to take their measurements, cut the patterns, and following sewing directions while making a super cute summer dress which is loose fitting, has tie straps, and gathers. It also works as a beach cover up. ✂✂

#### **Sewing 101**

Age 8+

Beginner Level

\$200 class fee includes supplies

5 sessions, 2:00 – 4:30pm

Kids will learn fundamental sewing skills as they make elastic waist pajama pants and a small tote bag. Students will learn how to take their measurements, read a pattern envelope and instructions, handle fabric, use tools, and follow and cut a pattern along with construction and finishing techniques. Threading the sewing machine, winding the bobbin, machine safety and how to use the machine is taught and reinforced along with safely using the iron for pressing. *Fabric, elastic, and thread is included in the class fee and will be selected by students at the end of the first session. Fabrics will need to be washed and dried to pre-shrink before the next session.* ✂

### **Week 6: Aug 1 - 5**

#### **Summer Fun Fashion**

Age 9+

Advanced Beginner level

\$175 class fee plus supplies

5 sessions, 10:30am – 1:00pm

Using a McCall's "Learn to Sew for fun" pattern, students will make a pleated tank top and a "paper-bag" waist skirt, shorts, or pants. Learn how to sew inverted pleats, pockets, the paper bag waist, along with garment construction and pressing techniques. Prerequisite: Sewing 101 or equivalent experience. ✂✂

## **Week 6: Aug 1 - 5 (con't)**

### **Summer Daze Quilt**

Age 8+

Beginner Level

\$200 class fee includes supplies

5 sessions, 2:00 – 4:30pm

Students will learn cutting, sewing, and machine quilting skills while making a cozy throw size rag quilt. "Rag" quilts have frayed edges and great visual textural appeal so kids can have fun mixing the fabrics and colors. ☞

## **Week 7: Aug 8 - 12**

### **Sewing 101**

Age 8+

Beginner level

\$200 class fee includes supplies

5 sessions, 10:30am – 1:00pm

Kids will learn fundamental sewing skills as they make elastic waist pajama pants and a small tote bag. Students will learn how to take their measurements, read a pattern envelope and instructions, handle fabric, use tools, and follow and cut a pattern along with construction and finishing techniques. Threading the sewing machine, winding the bobbin, machine safety and how to use the machine is taught and reinforced along with safely using the iron for pressing. *Fabric, elastic, and thread is included in the class fee and will be selected by students at the end of the first session. Fabrics will need to be washed and dried to pre-shrink before the next session.* ☞

Beginner level

5 sessions, 2:00 – 4:30pm

Create something new out of something old or used in this creative reuse class. Students will bring in clean used clothing and/or textiles from home or thrift stores. We will have some clothes, scrap fabric, trims and embroidery floss from the classroom available too. ☞

## **Week 8: Aug 15 - 19**

### **Bag It!**

Age 8+

Advanced beginner level

\$200 class fee includes supplies

5 sessions 10:30 – 1:00pm

Kids will sew up a cross body bag with applique, embroidery & zipper, a pencil case, and a striped ribbon zip pouch. Our Sewing 101 or equivalent sewing experience is helpful. ☞☞

### **Cozy Sweatshirt or Hoodie**

Age 11+

Advanced beginner level

\$210 class fee includes supplies

5 sessions, 2:00 – 4:30pm

Students will learn how to take their measurements, cut the patterns, and following sewing directions while making either a hoodie or pullover sweatshirt with kangaroo pocket. Our Sewing 101 or equivalent sewing experience is helpful. ☞☞

## **Week 9: Aug 22 - 26**

### **T-Shirt Dress**

Age 12+

Advanced beginner level

\$190 class fee includes supplies

5 sessions, 10:30am – 12:30pm

Students will learn how to work with stretch knit fabrics while making a t-shirt dress. There are a few style choices within this pattern they will choose from in the first session then shop for the appropriate fabric in the store. Learning to follow directions, pinning, cutting, measuring, sewing are all part of the class as well. More sewing techniques to build on after taking Sewing 101 which is recommended. ☞☞

## **Week 9: Aug 22 - 26 (cont'd)**

### **Sewing 101**

Age 8+

Beginner level

\$200 class fee includes supplies

5 sessions, 2:00 – 4:30pm

Kids will learn fundamental sewing skills as they make elastic waist pajama pants and a small tote bag. Students will learn how to take their measurements, read a pattern envelope and instructions, handle fabric, use tools, and follow and cut a pattern along with construction and finishing techniques. Threading the sewing machine, winding the bobbin, machine safety and how to use the machine is taught and reinforced along with safely using the iron for pressing. *Fabric, elastic, and thread is included in the class fee and will be selected by students at the end of the first session. \$130 class fee includes supplies

4 sessions, 10:30 – 12:30pm

All of the project in this class will be made with hand sewing and embroidery. Various hand sewing and embroidery stitches will be taught while making each project. A great class for all levels. ✂

### **Back to School Messenger Bag**

Age 10+

Advanced beginner level

\$145 class fee plus supplies, includes pattern

4 sessions, 2:00 – 4:30pm

Head back to school with a cool cross body messenger bag. Kids will learn how to cut the pattern, apply interfacings, sewing in lining, make a strap, a patch pocket, and flap along with top stitching and edge stitching. ✂✂

## **Fabricland Registration, Tuition, and Classroom Policies:**

As of this printing face masks are optional.

**Tools & Supplies:** Students must come to each class prepared with their own tools, supplies, and materials if required. Tools must be labeled with students name or initials.

**Payment & Refund Policy:** Payment in full is required for class registration. There are no refunds on classes. A student may reschedule a class once provided notice is given at least 72 hours prior to class time. Rescheduled classes must be taken within the Summer Camp time frame. If Fabricland needs to cancel a class due to lack of enrollment, students will be given their choice of a refund or a substitution class. There are no refunds or rescheduling if canceling out of a class within 72 hours of class date and time. Fabricland is not responsible for a registrant's decision not to complete a course nor will receive compensation if classes are missed.

**Attention Parents:** When dropping off your children, please check-in with the instructor before leaving your child. Please pick-up children at the designated time. If someone different will be picking up your child please give their name and phone number to the teacher. There is no supervision outside of classroom hours. Please arrive prepared to start on time. In consideration of all students, latecomers may be turned away at the discretion of the teacher.

Please mark your calendar with the date the class is scheduled to begin. Fabricland will not call or send out additional reminders before the class starts.

Kids may bring a light snack and beverage. If staying for the morning and afternoon sessions they can bring lunch and stay.
